

31 Days of Fasting & Prayer

Week 2 – October 8th – 14th 2017

Liquid Prayer: “As soon as I heard these things...I wept...” Nehemiah 1:4



ABSTRACT

To pray with tears is to make an eternal investment. To pray with tears is to sow your tears with eternal harvest.

INTRODUCTION:

We continue our second week of the Fasting by meditating on the second thing Nehemiah did as he inquired on the state of Jerusalem before God. As previously discussed, the book opens with this staggering statement from Nehemiah: As soon as I heard these words I sat down and wept and mourned for days, and I continued fasting and praying before the God of heaven – Nehemiah 1:4

Nehemiah did five things:

1. I sat down
2. **I wept**
3. I mourned for days
4. I continued fasting
5. I prayed before the God of heaven

During this week of the Fasting, we will enter the next dimension in prayer called **Travailing Prayer or Liquid Prayer**. This is a prayer washed in tears, groaning, wailing, lamenting and agonizing before God.

What is travail and how can it be called a dimension of prayer?

Truthfully, it's not spoken of much in churches. The dictionary calls it *hard or agonizing labor, toil as in childbirth, deep distress or anguish encountered in achievement*. Sometimes (as we'll see) it's not a pretty sight, except maybe to God. Most Christians don't encounter travail because we do not initiate it; God initiates it.

Consider Jeremiah. He served as a prophet to the nation of Israel while they played the harlot with false gods when God's judgment finally fell. He was there when **"Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came, he and all his army, against Jerusalem, camped against it and built a siege wall all around it."** (Jeremiah 52:4) Jeremiah had warned the people it was coming but they rejected him. Still, when Jerusalem fell he didn't gloat. Rather, he was devastated and prayed for mercy even though he knew none was coming.

Jeremiah is known as the weeping prophet and for good reason. He is a good picture for us of what travail looks like. **"My soul, my soul! I am in anguish! Oh, my heart!"** (Jeremiah 4:19) **"Oh that my head were waters and my eyes a fountain of tears, that I might weep day and night for the slain of the daughter of my people!"** (Jeremiah 9:1) **"My heart is broken within me, all my bones tremble; I have become like a drunken man, even like a man overcome with wine."** (Jeremiah 23:9)

After the demise of Jerusalem, Jeremiah wrote a soul scorching lament in which he says, **"For these things I weep; my eyes run down with water; because far from me is a**

comforter, One who restores my soul. My children are desolate because the enemy has prevailed.” (Lamentations 1:16)

I like to call travail, liquid prayer because there are almost never any words—no petitions—no pleadings—no claiming or declaring. Instead, there is strong emotion poured out in weeping, wailing and groanings. **“In the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words.”**(Romans 8:26)

That passage is often used to describe praying in the spirit or praying in tongues but I think it more accurately describes travail or praying with agonizing tears and sobs.

At times God calls us to weep (Eccl. 3:4). This is His call to empathy, to vicarious intercessory identification with others. At such times, we must be sure to pray "us" prayers and not "them" prayers. We must identify with those in need, rather than condemn and accuse. Instead of praying, "Lord, forgive them for being so cold," we should pray, "Lord, forgive us as a church for being so cold. Help us to be more loving, help us to pray more, help us to be more effective for You."

How Travail Works – Weeping in Prayer

Let's talk about how travail usually works. When a spirit of travail comes to a person, it totally bypasses their mind and intellect. When you reach this dimension of prayer you go beyond your natural self. Your prayers pass the stage of reason, planning, and strategy. This dimension of prayer is activated by the Holy Spirit. You enter the stage where there are no words to articulate your prayer and you are so burden with the situation that all you can do is sob with uncontrollable tears. The Bible calls it "groaning too deep for words." Have you ever gotten to that point in your prayer life, where words will not do? It is as if God pours into a willing partner his own emotions about an issue so they then become a point of contact on the earth for God's will to be worked through. **“Your kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.”** (Matthew 6:10)

Response

Have you ever felt such a call to liquid prayer or praying with groaning? How did you respond? When it happens for the first time it's common to feel some hesitation or even embarrassment, especially if you have no experience or teaching along these lines. Before resisting though, is a good idea to remember who drew you to such deep intercession. God produces the burden as He may wish to accomplish something very special through you. It is a privilege to be part of it.

If you have never experienced travail, have you ever witnessed it? Here again, the right response can help to support it and the wrong one can short-circuit God's purposes. I've seen people become distressed when someone else is in travail and try to shut it down by shushing the person or comforting them as if they are personally in distress. This distraction sometimes diminishes the prayer's fullness.

The best response to travail is to quietly pray in the spirit, perhaps with a gentle hand resting on their shoulder. Or, withdraw from the area and leave them to finish what God has started. If others approach and seem concerned, explain what is happening and ask them to leave or sit quietly and pray also. The one who is travailing is perfectly aware of what is going on around them but they need to have the freedom to carry their prayer to completion.

One who has experienced travail has experienced a deep connection to God's heart. That one has felt what God feels and knows that He is a God of very intense emotions. Should this type of prayer come knocking at your door, will you open wide?

Nehemiah opens his petition with soul travail – I said, when I heard these things I wept. How about you? This kind of weeping in prayer is not carnal, it's not bursting in tears because a matter or a situation hurts you. This dimension of prayer is truly spiritual; it is God initiated and provoked in you. You can't control it. You can feel you're in connection with God and you're expressing yourself, though you can't form words to express it. Deep tears or groans in prayer is a spiritual communication that can accelerate the results of your prayer request if you remain tuned with God.

In this devotional, I invite you to desire a spiritual experience of groaning before God that is too deep for words to express.

Day 8 – October 8th 2017

Scripture Reading: Nehemiah 8 (read entire chapter)

"Those who sow in tears will reap with songs of joy. He who goes out weeping, carrying seed to sow, will return with songs of joy, carrying sheaves with him" (Psa. 126:5-6).

Tears are precious in the sight of God when they are tears of longing, shed in intercession, or tears of joy as you praise God for answered prayer. The Son of God knows what it means to weep in prayer. The shortest verse in the Bible, "*Jesus wept*" (John 11:35), not only speaks volumes about the love and compassion of Jesus; it also explains the relation of tears to the intercession of Jesus. He who weeps *with us wept for us* as He wrestled with the powers of darkness in the Garden (Heb. 5:7).

Let us make very clear that we are not talking about tears of self-pity. Such tears can be basically carnal. They may give relief from tension, for "a good cry" often helps the mood of a discouraged or depressed person. But recurring tears of self-pity give no testimony to spiritual depth or power. We are here discussing the power of tears resulting from deep spiritual desire.

You should never be ashamed of tears shed in loving intercession. In fact, they testify to God of the depth of your identity with those for whom you intercede, the intensity of longing which underlies your intercession, and serve as a testimony of the Holy Spirit praying through you. Tears add a personal and private dimension of poignancy and power.

Such weeping intercession is much more likely to occur when you are alone with God. Normally, our private prayer can be more deep and intense than our public prayer. Tears are so intensely personal that the praying soul can weep more naturally and freely when only God is the witness to the tears. It is possible, however, to have a weeping spirit even when no literal tear runs down your cheek. God looks on your heart above all else (1 Sam. 16:7).

Your tears, like your words, are very important. However, God sees and knows you as you really are (2 Sam. 7:20; John 21:17). God knows the secret depths of your longing even better than you can express it. By deeply identifying with those for whom you pray, seek to deepen your heart cry to God. But do not seek to produce outward tears. That would be hypocritical.

Welcome the tears when the Holy Spirit gives them, but seek only to feel in your innermost heart the depth of yearning, which the Spirit feels.

LOG-ON: Morning Prayer

- 1) Turn again my captivity, O Lord, as the streams of the south, in the name of Jesus.
- 2) Heal my backsliding, O Lord, and take not Your Holy Spirit from me, in the name of Jesus.
- 3) Father, let me see Your glory in the mirror of Your word and be changed by it, in the name of Jesus.
- 4) Empower me, O Lord, to daily deny worldly and dishonourable affections and desires, in the name of Jesus.
- 5) Father, let Your voice be my only law and Your smile, my only reward, in the name of Jesus.
- 6) Hold me by Thy hand, O Lord, and make my crooked places straight, in the name of Jesus.
- 7) O LORD, Let Your name be honoured in my conduct and conversation, in the name of Jesus.
- 8) My Father, lead me to the rock that is higher than I, in Jesus' name.
- 9) In the shadow of Your wings, O Lord, I will make my refuge, in the name of Jesus.
- 10) O God, arise and sustain me by Your strong arm, in the name of Jesus.
- 11) My Father, clean my feet, hands, and lips from the stains of the flesh and spirit, in the name of Jesus.
- 12) O Lord, teach me to live a holy life in the fear of the Lord, in the name of Jesus.
- 13) My Father, refresh and quicken me by the power of the Holy Ghost, in the name of Jesus.
- 14) Empower me to give to the world what You planned when You sent me into the world, in the name of Jesus.
- 15) My Father, make me humble and unselfish, in Jesus' name.
- 16) Give me, O Lord, childlike faith to receive what You offer, in the name of Jesus.
- 17) Father, give me a pilgrim's spirit, in the name of Jesus.
- 18) Enable me, O lord, to be in the world, but not of the world, in the name of Jesus.
- 19) Under the covering of the Superior Blood of Jesus, I declare, Every selfish craving within my soul, die, in the name of Jesus.
- 20) Empower me to always obey Your heavenly calling, in Jesus' name.
- 21) O LORD, Lay Your hand upon me to cover my head from attacks, in Jesus' name.

LOG-OFF: Evening Prayers

1. O Lord, give me encouragement in the time of despair, in Jesus' name.
2. O Lord, give me guidance in the time of uncertainty, in the name of Jesus.
3. Help me, Lord, to draw closer to You, day by day, in the name of Jesus.
4. Father, empower me to hear Your voice and discern Your will, in the name of Jesus.
5. Father, save me from becoming over-familiar with You, in Jesus' name.
6. The God who does more than I can ever ask or think, manifest Your power in my life, in the name of Jesus.
7. Teach me, Lord, to seek Your will and pursue what is right, in the name of Jesus.
8. Help me, Lord, to love You without reservation, in Jesus' name.
9. O God, challenge and confront me through Your word and meet with me in prayers, in the name of Jesus.
10. I release myself from the fears and anxieties that weigh me down, in the name of Jesus.
11. I release myself from powers destroying my confidence and undermining my happiness, in the name of Jesus.
12. Almighty God, by Your power, teach me to see with Your eyes, in the name of Jesus.
13. O Lord, show me the way through my obstacles, in Jesus' name.
14. O Lord, show me the way through my limitations, in the name of Jesus.
15. O Lord, show me opportunities where men see despair, in Jesus' name.
16. Teach me, O Lord, the secret of prayer, in the name of Jesus.
17. Teach me, O Lord, the power of prayer, in the name of Jesus.
18. Teach me, O Lord, the potentials of prayer, in Jesus' name.
19. O Lord, make the best that You can of me for Your glory, in Jesus' name.
20. Fix my heart, O Lord, on You, in the name of Jesus.
21. My Father, keep me from hiding my light under the load of anxieties, in the name of Jesus.

Day 9 – October 9th 2017

Scripture Reading: Nehemiah 9 (read entire chapter)

As we enter the 9th day of our Fasting, we must seek to meditate on what it means to “Weep before the LORD” as Nehemiah did. Many of God’s chosen servants have prayed with groaning and tears until the petition was granted. Observe these ones:

Job testified, *“Have I not wept for those in trouble? Has not my soul grieved for the poor?”* (Job 30:25). Moses and others of the children of Israel wept over the sin of their people (Num. 25:6). David testified as to how he wept and fasted for God’s people (Psa. 69:10). Isaiah wept for the need of his people (Isa. 16:9). God told King Josiah: *“Because your heart was responsive and you humbled yourself before the Lord...and because you tore your robes and wept in My presence, I have heard you, declares the Lord”* (2 Kgs. 22:19).

When Ezra wept for his people, they began to weep and pray also (Ezra 10:1). Nehemiah *“sat down and wept [for Jerusalem]. For some days I mourned and fasted and prayed before the God of heaven”* (Neh. 1:4).

Jeremiah was known as the weeping prophet because of the great prayer burden he carried for his people. *“Since my people are crushed, I am crushed; I mourn...Oh, that my head were a spring of water and my eyes a fountain of tears! I would weep day and night for...my people”*(Jer. 8:21; 9:1). *“If you do not listen, I will weep in secret because of your pride; my eyes will weep bitterly, overflowing with tears”* (13:17). *“Let my eyes overflow with tears night and day without ceasing; for my virgin daughter – my people – has suffered a grievous wound, a crushing blow”* (14:17). *“My eyes fail from weeping, I am in torment within, my heart is poured out on the ground because my people are destroyed”* (Lam. 2:11). *“Streams of tears flow from my eyes because my people are destroyed. My eyes will flow unceasingly, without relief, until the Lord looks down from heaven and sees. What I see brings grief to my soul”* (3:48-51).

Paul, the great missionary apostle, was also known for his ministry of tears. *“I wrote you out of great distress and anguish of heart and with many tears”* (2 Cor. 2:4). *“You know how I lived the whole time I was with you...I served the Lord with great humility and with tears”* (Acts 20:18-19). *“Remember that for three years I never stopped warning each of you night and day with tears”* (20:31).

Truly, the act of weeping before God has been a chosen weapon by some of God’s choicest servants. You should not be ashamed to join the company of these ones.

LOG-ON: Morning Prayer

Enter these declarations and pray one each point for 5 to 10 minutes as time permits.

- 1) Father, give me a loving and thankful heart, in Jesus' name.
- 2) O Father, Make me a palace of which every room is freely open to the Lord, in the name of Jesus.
- 3) Make me a blessing, O Lord, to those with whom I come in contact with, in the name of Jesus.
- 4) O Father, When my eyes open in heaven, may I see You and hear Your 'well done' commendation, in the name of Jesus.
- 5) Keep me away, O Lord, from all that would grieve Your Holy Spirit, in the name of Jesus.
- 6) Help me, O Lord, to remove my gaze from dark clouds and focus on Your rainbow, in the name of Jesus.
- 7) Help me, O Lord, not to focus on the waves and the wind, but on the face of JESUS, in the name of Jesus.
- 8) Help me, O Lord, never to complain about Your discipleship, in the name of Jesus.
- 9) My Father, take the burden I cannot bear and wipe the tears I cannot keep back, in the name of Jesus.
- 10) I shall not fail under Your discipleship, O Lord, in Jesus' name.
- 11) Blessed Holy Spirit, give me joy that is unspeakable, in Jesus' name.
- 12) Blessed Holy Spirit, give me love that passes knowledge, in Jesus; name.
- 13) Blessed Holy Spirit, give me peace beyond understanding, in the name of Jesus.
- 14) O Lord my God, graciously draw near to me and cover my head when I am in trouble, in the name of Jesus.
- 15) I render null and void, all craftiness and subtlety of the devil assigned against me, in the name of Jesus.
- 16) Teach me to pray. O Lord, as You taught Your disciples, in the name of Jesus.
- 17) Direct my prayers, O Lord, that I may ask for things that are according to Your will, in the name of Jesus.
- 18) O LORD, Present me finally faultless before the presence of Your glory, in the name of Jesus.
- 19) O LORD, Cleanse my conscience and enlighten my heart, in Jesus' name.
- 20) Let nothing prevent the inflowing of Your love to my heart, in the name of Jesus.
- 21) Father, kindle my love for You by Your Holy breath, in Jesus' name.

Day 10 – October 9th 2017

Scripture Reading: Nehemiah 10 (read and meditate on entire chapter)

God Calls Us to Pray with Tears

God called through the prophet Joel, *"Return to Me with all your heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning"* (Joel 2:12). He calls Christian leaders to pray with tears for their people: *"Let the priests, who minister before the Lord, weep between the temple porch and the altar. Let them say, 'Spare Your people, O Lord'...Why should they say among the peoples, 'Where is their God?'"* (2:17). God knows and records our tears: *"List my tears on Your scroll – are they not in Your record?"* (Psa. 56:8). Our day is similar to that faced by Isaiah. *"The Lord, the Lord Almighty, called you on that day to weep"* (Isa. 22:12).

It will take more than tears to make prayer effective; but a burdened heart, a soul crying out to God, is the very essence of intercession. It is a spiritual crime to be calloused while the world goes to hell. It is spiritually criminal to pray casually, dry-eyed and burdenless, while a world is in sin and pain. It is Christ-like for your heart to weep with those who weep (Rom. 12:15). It is Christ-like for you to be so filled with loving compassion that you pray with tears for those broken, fettered, and destroyed by sin.

Prayer is not recreational or arbitrary for the Christian. Prayer is the very business of Christ's kingdom. Prayer is joining with God the brokenhearted Father, Christ the weeping High Priest, and the tender, interceding Holy Spirit by sharing their heartbeat and bearing with them the same burdens which they carry in their loving hearts.

To pray with tears is to make an eternal investment. To pray with tears is to sow your tears with eternal harvest. No tear shed in burdened intercession for others is ever forgotten by God, unrecorded, or in vain. Intercession watered with your tears is one of the most powerful forms of prayer known. As surely as God is in heaven, *"Those who sow in tears will reap with songs of joy. He who goes out weeping, carrying seed to sow, will return with songs of joy, carrying sheaves with him"* (Psa. 126:5-6).

LOG-ON: Morning Prayers

Enter these declarations and pray one each point for 5 to 10 minutes as time permits.

CONFESSION: Isaiah 40:30-31: ***“Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall: But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.”***

- 1) Heavenly Father, fence me around with Your protecting care, in the name of Jesus.
- 2) Father, empower me to finish my course with joy and receive the crown of life, in the name of Jesus.
- 3) My Lord, be the physician of my soul, in the name of Jesus.
- 4) Father, heal all the diseases of my soul, in the name of Jesus.
- 5) Father, lighten my heart with the knowledge of Your truth, in the name of Jesus.
- 6) Purify me, O Lord, by the fire of Your Holy Spirit, in the name of Jesus.
- 7) Heavenly Father, wash my life with pure water, in the name of Jesus.
- 8) Holy Ghost, help me to live as an uncluttered man, in Jesus' name.
- 9) Feed me, O lord, with Your flesh and blood according to Your power, in the name of Jesus.
- 10) O true Vine of God, abide in me by fire, in the name of Jesus.
- 11) O Lord, deliver me from the terror of the night, in the name of Jesus.
- 12) Empower me, O lord, to lean on Your strength, in Jesus' name.
- 13) Fountain of life, spring up in me, in the name of Jesus.
- 14) Light of lie, Jesus Christ, illuminate my life, in Jesus' name.
- 15) Overshadow me with the comfort and peace that no one can take away, in the name of Jesus.
- 16) Help me, O Lord, to take up my cross and follow You, in Jesus' name.
- 17) O Lord, support me with Your mighty power and enable me to become more than a conqueror, in the name of Jesus.
- 18) Give me the grace, O god, to be steadfast, unmovable and strong, in the name of Jesus.
- 19) My Father, write Your law upon my heart, in Jesus' name.
- 20) Father, let the leaves of the tree of life be for my health, in Jesus' name.
- 21) Father, let Your peace settle down upon my soul, in the name of Jesus.

LOG-OFF: Evening Prayers

Enter these declarations and pray one each point for 5 to 10 minutes as time permits.

CONFESSION: Isaiah 40:30-31: ***“Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall: But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.”***

1. Minister nourishment to my soul, in the name of Jesus.
2. My Father, do not let sin have dominion over my life, in Jesus' name.
3. When I am fiercely tempted, O lord, do not let me yield, in the name of Jesus.
4. Be the Alpha and Omega of every moment of my life, in Jesus' name.
5. Let the fire of Your love consume every sinful desire in me, in the name of Jesus.
6. Keep me, O lord, in quietness of spirit, in the name of Jesus.
7. Help me, O Lord, to make others glad, in the name of Jesus.
8. Help me to serve You in opening blind eyes and turning men and women from darkness to light, in the name of Jesus.
9. Father, let Your power work through my hands, in Jesus' name.
10. Give me uncommon wisdom to enable me know what I ought to know, in the name of Jesus.
11. Give me grace, O lord, so that I would never grieve Your Holy Spirit, in the name of Jesus.
12. Power of wandering from the flock, die, in the name of Jesus.
13. My Father, make me sensitive to Your voice, in Jesus' name.
14. I shall not have fellowship with the works of darkness, in Jesus' name.
15. When the storm is fierce, let me hear You saying, 'it is I, be not afraid', in the name of Jesus.
16. I shall never go in front or loiter behind Your pillar of fire, in the name of Jesus.
17. My Father, let me live in the spirit of prayer all my days, in the name of Jesus.
18. Oh God, cancel every evil ordinance against my life, in Jesus' name.
19. Every gate of oppression, close up, in the name of Jesus.
20. Oh Lord, go before me and make my path straight, in the name of Jesus.
21. Begin to thank the Lord for this session.

Day 11 – October 11th 2017

Scripture Reading: Nehemiah 11 – read and meditate on entire chapter

We should weep because humanity has forsaken God! The nations have forgotten God (Psa. 9:17). They do not want to retain the knowledge of God (Rom. 1:28). They show contempt for God's constant kindness, tolerance and patience (Rom. 2:4). Often they are hardened by God's judgments and their reaping of what they have sown (Rom. 2:5; Rev. 16:21). We should weep for our world: "Lord, forgive our wayward race!"

Why should we not weep when satanic inspired legislations are passed in our Congress every year? Christianity needs a heart with compassion to cry for a world that is laughing it's way to hell.

LOG-ON: Morning Prayer

Enter these declarations and pray one each point for 5 to 10 minutes as time permits.

CONFESSION: MICAH 7:8: ***“Rejoice not against me, O mine enemy: when I fall, I shall arise; when I sit in darkness, the Lord shall be a light unto me.”***

1. Lord Jesus, thank You for giving Your Church, Evangelists to perfect us.
2. Lord Jesus, thank You for giving Your Church, Pastors to perfect us.
3. Lord Jesus, thank You for giving Your Church, Teachers to perfect us.
4. O God, I thank You for giving me a tongue that is like the best silver.
5. O God, I thank You for You are a covenant-keeping God.
6. O God, I thank You for You give mercy and peace to all who keep Your covenant.
7. O God, I thank You for You are not a man who lies – You will do what You have promised.
8. O God, I thank You for You are not slack concerning Your promises.
9. Father of Truth, I thank You for You have promised never to leave me.
10. Father of Truth, I thank You for You have promised never to forsake me.
11. Father of Truth, I thank You for You have promised to deliver me.
12. Father of Truth, I thank You for You have promised to be my sun and shield.
13. Father of Truth, I thank You for You have promised to give me all good things.
14. Father of Truth, I thank You for You have promised to give me Your angels.
15. My hand, catch the Holy Spirit fire and be on the neck of my enemies, in the name of Jesus.
16. Lord, command Your blessings upon my life by fire, in the name of Jesus.
17. Favour of God, arise, cause my horn to be exalted, in the name of Jesus.
18. My Father, reveal the things that belong to me, in Jesus' name.
19. My Father, let Your glory be revealed in my life, in Jesus' name.
20. Empower me, O Lord, to speak the mysteries of Christ, in Jesus' name.
21. Lord, light my candles and dispel my darkness, in Jesus' name.

Enter these declarations and pray one each point for 5 to 10 minutes as time permits.

CONFESSION: MICAH 7:8: *“Rejoice not against me, O mine enemy: when I fall, I shall arise; when I sit in darkness, the Lord shall be a light unto me.”*

Scripture Reading: Nehemiah 12 – read and meditate on the entire chapter

We should weep because sin is multiplying!

Evil people are going from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived (2 Tim. 3:13). The sins listed in Second Timothy 3:1-5 are all too evident: loving self rather than loving God, boastfulness, pride, abusiveness, disobedience to parents, ungratefulness, unholiness, unloveliness, unforgiveness, slander, lack of self-control, brutality, despising the good, treachery, rashness, conceit, love of pleasure more than love of God.

All these combined with the gross sins of sexual perversion, rape and pornography, have hardened our national conscience. Crime has escalated. Terrorism, sadism, and calculated cruelty have reached unimaginable proportions. War is ever more terrible, and peace seems constantly precarious. Man seems on the verge of destroying himself. How can we but weep: "Lord, have mercy on our sinful race!"

We should weep because as a church we are too lifeless and powerless!

We can thank God for the dedicated believers in many parts of the world, and for what He is doing through them. We also bless God for what He is doing amongst us here at Honeywell Baptist Church. But the world has lost its respect for the Christian church in general for we do not bring glory to God as we should.

We have the "*reputation of being alive,*" but all too often we are spiritually dead (Rev. 3:1). We lack the power that should witness to the world of spirituality and godliness (2 Tim. 3:5). There is a drifting or departure from sound doctrine, and false cults are multiplying (2 Tim. 4:3-4). Too often our spiritual condition is typified by the Laodicean church; we do not realize how lukewarm, pitiful, spiritually impoverished, spiritually blind, and spiritually naked we appear to God (Rev. 3:17).

What a small percentage of good churches are really characterized by revival, by constant soul-winning by the majority of the membership, and a sacrificial involvement in missionary enterprise. We need to weep for ourselves: "Lord, revive us again!"

Enter these declarations and pray one each point for 5 to 10 minutes as time permits.

1. Thank You Father for the promise which says, "I will build my church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it."
2. I ask for forgiveness of every sin causing disunity and powerlessness in the body of Christ.
3. I take authority, over the power of darkness in all its ramifications, in the name of Jesus.
4. I bind and cast out, every spirit causing seduction, false doctrine, deception, hypocrisy, pride and error, in Jesus' name.
5. Every plan and strategy of satan, against the body of Christ, be bound, in the name of Jesus.
6. Every spirit of prayerlessness, discouragement and vainglory in the body of Christ, be bound, in the name of Jesus.

We have largely lost the witnessing, soul-winning passion of the early church. We are upset by blatant sins, but fail to be disturbed by Christians who have never won a soul to Christ, by Christians whose prayer is mostly self-centered and who seldom weep for the world. Earth's largest and whitest harvest since Pentecost is here, and we live a life of "business as usual"; we tend to play church and to treat missions as a mere hobby instead of as the major task of the church.

May God move us to tears: "Lord, awaken me, and stir me and my church again and again!"

"Lord, give us tears as we pray!"
